## National Trust Staffordshire Centre - Guidance Notes For Walkers

All those who join our walks do so at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety. It is the walker's responsibility to ensure that: -

- You book a place in advance on the walk on the website Book A Walk page or directly with the Walk Leader, using the contact details provided in the News Bulletin.
- You wear appropriate clothing and footwear.
- Carry a first aid kit suitable for minor injuries such as blisters, bites, cuts and sprains.
- Keep in sight of those walking in front of you and behind you. When turning off path, check that those behind know where to go.
- If you do lose touch with the party and are unable to contact the leader, stay where you are or return to the last known point on the route.
- Observe the Country Code
- Walk in single file across cultivated or ploughed land.
- Walk on the right-hand side of roads in single file facing oncoming traffic, or as otherwise instructed by the leader.
- Walkers with a smart phone are recommended to download copies of the St John Ambulance and what3words apps if possible.
