# **Tour Itinerary**

This morning we journey north to Yorkshire, heading to Historic Haddon Hall, the most perfect house to survive from the middle ages. On our guided tour of the hall, explore the 900 year architectural, social and family history. Learn about life within the walls of Haddon and how the Tudor kitchens functioned. Discover the rare frescoes and tapestries, before continuing our journey to The Bridge Hotel, our home for the next 4 nights. (D)

#### Tuesday 20th May 2025

Today, we visit York, for an included guided tour of the Minster, one of the world's most magnificent cathedrals. York Minster has been at the centre of Christianity in the north of England since the 7th century, every aspect of this ancient building, from the exquisite, handcrafted stone through to the unrivalled collection of medieval stained glass tells a story. Afternoon at leisure to explore this fantastic walled city, before returning to our hotel. (B,D)

#### Wednesday 21st May 2025

This morning we visit Hepworth Wakefield Gallery, named after the 20th century artist Barbara Hepworth. The Gallery is home to Wakefield's art collection, an impressive compendium of modern British art and artists. The gallery, dedicated to her work, permanently displays 44 plaster and aluminium prototypes, together with the artist's work bench and tools. An afternoon at National Trust Nostell Priory, a Georgian house set in 300 acres of majestic gardens and parkland. A treasure trove of gems, with interiors by Robert Adams, a world-class Thomas Chippendale collection and a rare 18th century dolls house. (B,D)

### Thursday 22nd May 2025

With a full day visit to National Trust and World Heritage Site of Studley Royal Park and Fountains Abbey. The ancient monastic abbey ruins, the largest in the country are located within the awe-inspiring 18th century water gardens. A Georgian landscape of formal and geometric design has extraordinary vistas including the Temple of Piety. (B,D)

#### Friday 23rd May 2025

After breakfast we depart for Wentworth Woodhouse. A grand Georgian house, once a Fitzwilliam family home, before being bought by the preservation trust in 2017. Explore the outstanding architecture of each room, learn about the royal visit of King George V and Queen Mary in 1912, through a fascinating sound and vision experience. Returning to Stafford, arriving early evening. (B)
