We want to be able to welcome everyone into the gallery and we are here to assist you.

Entry to the gallery

There is a gently sloped ramp to take you straight into the gallery. Alternatively, there are two shallow steps with a sturdy handrail to take you straight to the entrance door.

Inside the gallery

There are two levels to the gallery. There is a ground level area where the main display of paintings and products and seasonal films are playing. This is also where you will be served a free, freshly-brewed coffee.

There are ample seating areas, for you to sit and relax and the gallery is spacious enough for a wheelchair to be manoeuvred easily on a smooth wooden floor.

Spacious toilet facilities are available and have been designed with wheelchair users in mind.

Upper gallery level

The upper level of the gallery is accessed by a gentle ambulant staircase, with handrails on both sides and a small landing half the way up, making it easier for those with restricted mobility.

There is a seating area in this upper level for visitors to rest and watch the films.

Robert's studio is on this level and is often open for you to look around.

This guided tour of the gallery will help you visually see the layout of the gallery.
